It plunges itself into an old volcanic crater, the first breathtaking view after 20 meters; the trails are all in gravel or concrete with a railing, 350+ steps, 25 minutes to base, the total average time needed for a round trip is 90 minutes, quick 60 minutes, 3.5 kilometers total, stunning views, forest, gardens, very peaceful, and many hummingbirds. No swimming as it is hazardous! Suitable for everybody if you take your time coming up.
